NAPLAN

Our NAPLAN testing for years 3 and 5 held on Tuesday 9 May, Wednesday 10 May and Thursday 11 May. The tests will assess students' skills and understanding in the areas of reading, writing, language conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy.

An individual NAPLAN report for each child will be sent home later this year. Results provide additional feedback for parents, carers and teachers on how students are progressing in key curriculum areas.

The best way you can help your child prepare for NAPLAN is to reassure your child that NAPLAN tests are just one part of their school program, and to urge them to simply do the best they can.

Student Safety

Student safety is a priority at school. This includes students arriving at and leaving school safely. The afternoon is particularly busy, and there is a lot of traffic immediately out the front of the school and on Dayboro Road. We expect that students who cross over Tandoor Drive to meet parents on the other side of the road will walk up to the lights and cross safely there. Tandoor Drive is far too busy for students to cross safely at other places. Also, the pick-up zone becomes clogged up when a car parks there. Please note that this is not a parking area. Parents should stop, children climb in the car, and they go. The entry gate to the school on Tandoor Drive is locked at 2.45 pm. This is again for student safety. In the last week we have had a couple of near-misses with children crossing at the wrong place, or parents driving through or parking in the wrong place. Please help us to keep your children safe.

At Petrie the safety of our students, staff, and parents/caregivers is of utmost priority while on our premises. In line with our Workplace Health and Safety procedures we are required as part of our Critical Incident Plan to hold one evacuation and one lockdown drill each term. Please ensure if you are volunteering at the school that you are aware of these procedures and you have signed in and out at our register in the office so we have an accurate list of all people on site each day.

NAPLAN

Next week students in Years 3 and 5 will participate in NAPLAN. All students in these year levels will participate, unless they are exempt or withdrawn by parents/carers. Classroom teachers are working hard to prepare students and to provide plenty of practice opportunities.



Late Arrivals and Early Departures

A student who arrives after 9.00 am is considered late. When a student is late for school, the Parent/Caregiver should report to the office to collect an "Early/Late" slip which will be printed by office staff.

Parents/Caregivers sign the visitor's book; collect a visitor's sticker to wear before escorting the student to class and handing the "Early/Late" slip to the teacher. Parents/Caregivers should then return to the office to sign out. For safety reasons, students are not permitted to move around the school on their own during class times, hence the need for a Parent/Caregiver to escort them.

If a Parent/Caregiver needs to collect a student early from school, they should first report to the office to collect an "Early/Late" slip which will be printed by office staff. Parents/Caregivers sign the visitor's book; collect a visitor's sticker to wear before taking the "Early/Late" slip to the class teacher to collect the student. For safety reasons, students are not permitted to leave class and come to the office on their own.

Student Reports

Student reports will be sent home at the end of this term. For the first time, reports will be emailed to parents. Please ensure that the school has an up-to-date email address to send students reports to. Parents should also add *Application.ONESCHOOL@dete.qld.gov.au* to their list of safe senders to ensure report card emails aren't sent to the Junk folder.

Another change that parents will notice is the learning area Humanities and Social Sciences on student reports. This is not a new Learning Area, but rather a combination of what was previously History, Geography, and

Civics and Citizenship. Students are interacting with the same learning content in an integrated way.

PREP 2018

We will soon begin taking enrolments for Prep for next year, and interviews for those enrolments will be carried out from 12th June. Children born between 1st July 2012 and 30th June 2013 will be the correct age for Prep in 2018. If you have a child in this age group, please contact the school office to enrol.
