Re: 2023 Curriculum Student Resource Scheme – Non-Participation

You have advised the school via the returned completed Student Resource Scheme (SRS) form that you do not wish to participate in the SRS for 2023. Parents/carers who choose not to participate in the SRS are responsible for providing their student with all items that would otherwise be provided by the SRS pack to enable their student to engage with the curriculum.
